TOURISM AND CULTURAL POTENTIAL – VALORIZATION OF THE BRZOZOWSKI DISTRICT

The aim of this paper is to present, kinds of promotion forms, which could be useful to develope cultural tourism in the Brzozowski district. The results of empirical research, showed that two objects from the UNESCO List located in its territory, as well as any other on the Wooden Architecture Trail, and Marian shrines - can be a powerful magnet for cultural tourists. Currently, they are poorly used, and promotion of attractiveness in the district, bases mainly on active tourism and recreation forms.

INTRODUCTION

The basic objectives of cultural tourism include : experiencing historical and religious sites, archaeological areas, urban complexes, museums, galleries, exhibitions, palaces, castles, mansions and other architectural objects; knowing and observing village culture in ethnographic museums, open-air museums, centers of tradition, studios and houses of folk art; visiting places of national remembrance, martyrdom, cemeteries and memorials related with well-known persons, taking part in events inspired in art or literature; visiting the military historic buildings, technical and industrial constructions (old and new); participation in kinds of performances such as cultural, religious and sports [3,4].

MATERIAL AND METHOD

The paper presents the attractiveness of the brzozowski district in terms of tourism and culture. County has monuments, which consists mainly local and regional tourism potential, however, has two objects inscribed on the UNESCO list. The empirical studies in the area were made at the turn of 2013/14 year, the valorization method created by A. Mikos von Rohrscheidt [3]. The results are shown in accordance with a research utilities, into four categories. The essential assessment of the attractiveness of the region is a Category I: Potential destinations for cultural tourism, in which the sum of obtained points classified the county according to the principle: less than 100 points - a small tourist and cultural potential; 101 - 250 points - an average potential; 251 - 450 points – a big potential; district for a total of more than 451 points - a great tourist and cultural potential. Whereas, categories II: tourist services; III: free time offer and IV: Factors supporting cultural tourism – have the complementary importance for the indexation.

RESEARCH RESULTS

Category I: Potential destinations for cultural tourism:

I.A : Monuments:

I.A. a) sacral buildings:

The historical basilica² (for the first two, points only if they are not cathedrals) (6) *Minor Basilica dedicated Assumption of most holy lady Mary* in the Stara Wieś from 1728 (6) Historical large size sacral complex³ Z⁴ (the first two) (6)

Stara Wieś - Jesuit monastery complex, containing parish church from 1728, the cemetery, monastery, currently collage from the eighteenth century, farm buildings from the middle of nineteenth century, and the garden (6)

Smaller or partially preserved historical sacred complex (the first two) (3)

Domaradz - partially preserved sacred complex, with the wooden church from the sixteenth to the nineteenth century, the wooden bell tower and ecclesiastical cemetery (3)

Brzozow - partially preserved sacred complex: parish church of 1686, and the missionaries monastery with college from the years 1745 to 1748 (3)

Significant historical temple of other religions ZD^5 (for the first two) (6)

Ulucz - St. Nicholas Wooden Orthodox Church, from 1510 (6)

Historical Shrine of national or regional (diocesan) (the first one) (6)

Starowiejska Mother of God Shrine, in the Stara Wieś (6)

Other sanctuary of the rank or regional sanctuary of importance like that, without historical worship (the first two) (3)

Sorrow Mother of God Shrine in Haczów that include the old and the new church (3) Unceasing Help Mother of God Shrine in Domaradz (3)

Another, significant architectural value religious building (the first three) (4)

Blizne – wooden parish church of All Saints, from the fifteenth century, inscribed the UNESCO list (4)

Haczów - wooden Church of the Assumption of most holy lady Mary , from the fourteenth century, inscribed the UNESCO list (4)

Golcowa – wooden parish church dedicated St. Barbra and the birth of the most holy lady Mary, from the fifteenth century (4)

I.A. b) Castles and palaces [2]:

Castle or historical palace, place of important historical events, ZD (the first three) (5)

Wzdów - Ostaszewskis palace, the 2nd half of XVIII century, in the late baroque style, rebuilt in the nineteenth century by Theophilus Adam Ostoja Ostaszewski giving it an eclectic character. Hugon Kołłątaj, Stanislaw Staszic and Wincenty Pol were hosted in the palace (5) *Nozdrzec - Skrzyńskis palace with elements of classicism, addition of romanticism and gothic* from 1843 and 1920. There were a section of border prevention in the years 1939-41, and in the years 1945 to 1947 palace served as a polish shelter from the terrorist militia of UPA (Ukrainian Insurgent Army) (5)

Grabownica Starzeńska - the brick palace, from 1675 - 1725. In the nineteenth century, completely rebuilt, gaining an eclectic features. During peasants inroad in 1846, the residence was totally robbed and vandalised (5)

Manor house or other residence , place of important events ZD (the first three) (6)

Wydrna - Sękowskis brick mansion, from 1845. The residence, among others, was visited by President Ignacy Moscicki and Melchior Wankowicz - the well known polish writer (6) *Izdebki – manor house*, from the 2nd half of eighteenth and nineteenth century, surrounded by a park with a pond. It belonged to the family of the Earl Bukowski and the Potocki family (6) *Haczów – manor complex*, from the 2nd half of eighteenth and nineteenth centuries (mansion, chapel, granary, orangery, entrance gate, park). The manor was attacked by the peasants during Galician inroad in 1846. During the Second World War it was used by the Germans, and during the communism in Poland, there was a school in here (6)

I.A. c) Other architectural and technical historic buildings:

The building of significant architectural value, the place of important events, ZD (the first three) (6)

Convent House of sisters-servants of the most holy lady Mary in the Stara Wieś, from 1874, where has stayed Catherine Faron - blessed the Catholic Church (6)

Building of Gymnastic Society "Falcon" in Brzozow, where the patriotic activities was leading from the years 1909-1910 (6)

The building of significant architectural value, the place of important events * Z (the first two **) (3)

Blizne - wooden parsonage of the eighteenth century, and the parish school with the organist house from 1866 (3)

The building of significant architectural value Z (the first three ****) (3)

The tenement house in Brzozow, at Market Square no. 2, built in the years 1850-1899 (3) *Brzozow - house with maid's room*, at Mickiewicza street no. 23, from the nineteenth/twentieth century (3)

Brzozow - facade of the house at Mickiewicza street no. 21, from the beginning of XIX in (3) Building, place of important events Z (the first two *****) (1)

Grabownica Starzenska - wooden parish school of the 2nd half of the nineteenth century (1) Individual monuments connected with the history of other ethnic groups , ZD (for the first two *) (4)

The remains of the former inhabitants of Greek -Catholic religion such as the ruins of the orthodox church in Grabowka (4)

The remains of the former inhabitants such as the Jewish cemetery in Brzozow (4) Monument of technology / industrial facility having regional importance ZD (up to three) (3) Oil wells in Grabownica Starzeńska (3)

Nozdrzec - mill turbine (3)

Dydnia - wooden granary (3)

Extra points for objects of cultural heritage:

Haczów - wooden church, from 1388, inscribed on the UNESCO's World Heritage List in 2003 in the class of Gothic cathedrals

Blizne - wooden church and parsonic complex, from 2 half of the fifteenth century, inscribed on the UNESCO's World Heritage List in 2003 in the class of Gothic cathedrals (*30*)

Extra points for all objects inscribed above classes:

Brzozow - Catholic Centre of Culture (1)

CONCLUSIONS

The aim of the study was to explore the tourist potential of the brzozowski district. Results of this study showed that the county received 251 points in the first category, which means that it has a big tourist and cultural potential [4]. It consists of both objects on the UNESCO List, two routes of Wooden Architecture Trail and historical multiculturalism of these lands. They testify residing here in the past the population of Roman Catholic, Greek Catholic, and Jewish.

Valorisation classifies the current state, gives an idea of the functioning of institutions of culture, sport and recreation and shows the scale of opportunity potential. It also reveal the deficiencies and weaknesses in the tourist service of the area. Valorisation indicates necessity to improve the tourist infrastructure , categorizing accommodation and food , organize entertainment and cultural events, prepare effective promotion of local and regional cuisine, etc.

Currently, one can observed a growing interest in human history. Scale of tourist movement in historical sites noticed progress. It can be clearly seen during the important or attractive events, visiting places associated with biography of historic persons, exploring regional culture and tradition. Valorisation revealed that these areas , with better promotion, and appropriate investment - could to strengthen branded tourist products of the subregion in the future. It can be told that potential of region could also included offer of so-called religious and pilgrimage tourism , biographical tourism, cultural, sporting and recreational events, using existing seasonal and year-round facilities.
